<p>MATCHING SUIT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Slacks or nice looking dress synthetic pants are acceptable. - Shirts, dress shirts, sweaters, tops, and turtlenecks are acceptable attire for work if they contribute to the appearance of formal, professional dress. - Matching suit jacket <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Slacks that are similar to Dockers and other makers of cotton or synthetic material pants, wool pants, flannel pants, and a sports coat. <p>ACCESSORIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tasteful, professional ties - Jewelry should be worn in good taste, with limited visible body piercing - Only head covers that are required for religious purposes or to honor cultural tradition are allowed. <p>SHOES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Conservative walking shoes, dress shoes, oxfords, loafers, or boots. - Must wear dress socks 	<p>MATCHING PANTSUIT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - See Men's Business attire <p>OR</p> <p>SKIRT SUIT, DRESS, SKIRT SET</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Dresses, skirts, skirts with jackets, dressy two-piece knit suits or sets, and skirts that are split at or below the knee are acceptable. - Dress and skirt length should be at a length at which you can sit modestly and comfortably in public. - Nothing too tight <p>APPROPRIATE SHIRTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - See Men's attire - No midriffs, or plunging necklines <p>ACCESSORIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Scarves, belts, and jewelry are encouraged. Jewelry should be worn in good taste, with limited visible body piercing. - Only head covers that are required for religious purposes or to honor cultural tradition are allowed. - Make-up should be relatively understated and appropriate for the time of day <p>SHOES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Conservative walking shoes, dress shoes, boots, flats, dress heels, and backless shoes - Must wear simple dress socks or stockings - No patterns or fishnets 	<p>PANTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jeans, sweatpants, exercise pants, Bermuda shorts, short shorts, shorts, bib overalls, leggings, and any spandex or other form-fitting pants such as people wear for exercise or biking. <p>SHIRTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tank tops; midriff tops; shirts with potentially offensive words, terms, logos, pictures, cartoons, or slogans; halter-tops; tops with bare shoulders or plunging necklines; golf-type shirts; sweatshirts; and t-shirts. <p>SKIRTS/DRESSES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Short, tight skirts that ride halfway up the thigh are inappropriate for work. Mini-skirts, skorts, sun dresses, beach dresses, and spaghetti-strap dresses. <p>SHOES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Athletic shoes, tennis shoes, thongs, flip-flops, slippers, and any casual shoe with an open toe. <p>ACCESSORIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Hats, flashy or plastic jewelry

BUSINESS CASUAL

<p>PANTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Slacks that are similar to Dockers and other makers of cotton or synthetic material pants, wool pants, flannel pants, and nice looking dress synthetic pants are acceptable. <p>SHIRTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Casual shirts, dress shirts, sweaters, vests, tops, golf-type shirts, and turtlenecks are acceptable attire. Most suit jackets or sport jackets are also acceptable attire. <p>ACCESSORIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tasteful, professional ties are optional - Jewelry should be worn in good taste, with limited visible body piercing - Only head covers that are required for religious purposes or to honor cultural tradition are allowed. <p>SHOES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Conservative walking shoes, loafers, clogs, boots, and leather deck-type shoes are acceptable for work. 	<p>PANTS, SKIRTS, DRESSES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Slacks that are similar to Dockers and other makers of cotton or synthetic material pants, wool pants, flannel pants, and nice looking dress synthetic pants are acceptable. - Casual dresses and skirts, and skirts that are split at or below the knee are acceptable. - Nothing too tight <p>SHIRTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Casual shirts, dress shirts, sweaters, vests, tops, and turtlenecks are acceptable attire. Most suit jackets are also acceptable attire. - No midriffs, or plunging necklines <p>ACCESSORIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Scarves, belts, and jewelry are encouraged. <p>PANTS, JEANS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All pants acceptable for business casual are also acceptable for casual. - Jeans must be plain jeans. Different washes and fades are acceptable. This means no patches, holes, fringe, beading, excessive stitch work, visible brands or logos. No denim shorts. - Shorts and Bermuda shorts in good condition are also acceptable <p>SHIRTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Casual shirts, dress shirts, sweaters, tops, golf-type shirts, and turtlenecks are acceptable attire. - Plain t-shirts or shirts with the school name are appropriate <p>ACCESSORIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jewelry should be in good taste, with limited visibility of body piercings. - Only head covers that are required for religious purposes or to honor cultural tradition are allowed. <p>SHOES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Athletic or walking shoes, loafers, clogs, sneakers, boots, flip flops, and sandals in good condition. 	<p>PANTS, JEANS, SKIRTS, DRESSES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All pants acceptable for business casual are also acceptable for casual. - Shorts and Bermuda shorts of an appropriate length and in good condition are also acceptable - Jeans must be plain jeans. Different washes and fades are acceptable. This means no patches, holes, fringe, beading, excessive stitch work, visible brands or logos. No denim shorts. - Casual dresses and skirts, and skirts that are split at or below the knee are acceptable. <p>SHIRTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Casual shirts, dress shirts, sweaters, tops, tank tops (not spaghetti straps) and turtlenecks are acceptable attire. - Plain t-shirts or shirts with the school name are appropriate <p>ACCESSORIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jewelry should be in good taste, with limited visibility of body piercings. - Only head covers that are required for religious purposes or to honor cultural tradition are allowed. <p>SHOES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Athletic or walking shoes, loafers, clogs, sneakers, boots, flip flops, sandals, tasteful heels, and backless shoes in good condition. 	<p>PANTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sweatpants, exercise pants, short shorts, bib overalls, and any spandex or other form-fitting pants such as people wear for exercise or biking. <p>SKIRTS/DRESSES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Short, tight skirts that ride halfway up the thigh, mini-skirts, skorts, beach dresses, and spaghetti-strap dresses. <p>SHIRTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Midriff tops; shirts with potentially offensive words, terms, logos, pictures, cartoons, or slogans; halter-tops; and tops with bare shoulders; tops with plunging necklines or bare backs. <p>SHOES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Slippers, shoes with any offensive message <p>ACCESSORIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Hats, flashy or plastic jewelry
